You must be at least 21 years of age to rent a campsite or tent site. Check-in time is 3 pm, check-out time is 2 pm. Early check-in and late check-out are available for an additional fee. Campers must register their camper or tent at Bobbers before setting up at site.

Quiet Time is 11pm – 8am. Keep your voices and music down and be respectful to other campers.

No firearms or fireworks are allowed on Scales Pointe grounds at any times. No chain saws or axes are allowed. Firewood is available for purchase at Bobbers. Out of State firewood and firewood from Allamakee County, Iowa is not allowed.

Anyone caught defacing picnic tables, or causing damage to shower houses or campground property will be fined, prosecuted and required to leave the grounds.

Motorcycles may be driven on main roads only. No Gators, Razors, ATV's, or 4-wheelers are allowed.

No more than two cars are allowed to be parked at each camp site. All other vehicles must be parked in Parking Lot "E". DO NOT PARK ON ANY CAMP SITE OTHER THAN YOUR OWN AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON!

Do not secure anything to trees using nails, screws, cable or chain. Do not hang clotheslines between trees.

Pets MUST be on leashes at all times and must be cleaned up after. Keep your pets quiet. Boats are not allowed to leave docks after 10:30 p.m. per DNR Regulations. Boats and trailers must be registered, display a pass and park in designated areas at all times. Boat trailers must park in Parking Lot "C" unless otherwise directed. Boat parking on campsites is prohibited. All boat trailers parked in non-designated areas will be ticketed and fined.

No more than four adults per tent. All non-paying tent guests must leave the grounds by midnight.

One tent per camper site is allowed at a cost of \$15 per night. This tent must be registered and display the appropriate sticker. All other tents must be in the designated tent camping areas. Tents must be registered before setting up. Tents without stickers will be removed by Scales Pointe staff.

Anyone under the age of 21 years of age caught drinking alcohol on Scales Pointe grounds will immediately be removed from the property. Each camper is responsible for his/her guests.

No carpets, rugs or mats are allowed to be placed on any grass at your campsite.

Any food or alcohol consumed on the outdoor patio must be purchased from Bobbers Grill.

Do not leave junk, trash and debris laying around your camper site. Dispose of all garbage promptly. Do not put food or plastic bottles of any kind in the fire rings at any time.

GOLF CART RULES AT SCALES POINTE

- 1. Effective March 1, 2011, all golf carts will be required to be registered at a cost of \$20.00 per season. This fee is waived for seasonal campers and for dock customers.
- 2. All golf carts must have working headlights if driven after dark.
- 3. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a State issued learner's permit or instructional permit to drive a golf cart and be able to immediately produce said permit upon request by Scales Pointe staff.
- 4. Minors without a State issued instructional permit may drive a golf cart with a parent or guardian only and during daylight hours only.
- 5. No person under the age of 16 is allowed to drive a golf cart after dark at any time.
- 6. No standing on golf carts and no hanging off the side of golf carts.
- 7. Golf carts may be driven on main roads only. No repetitive driving.
- 8. Speed limit of 15 mph must be obeyed at all times.
- 9. The golf cart owner is responsible to Scales Pointe for damages caused by golf carts and/or the person driving them, regardless of whether the driver owns the golf cart or not. For example: If you loan your golf cart to someone and they violate the golf cart rules, this violation will be against your golf cart and NOT the person driving it.

First Offense: Verbal Warning

Second Offense: \$25 fine

Third Offense: Golf cart removed from Scales Pointe premises for the remainder of the season.

No refund on golf cart registration fees for any reason.
